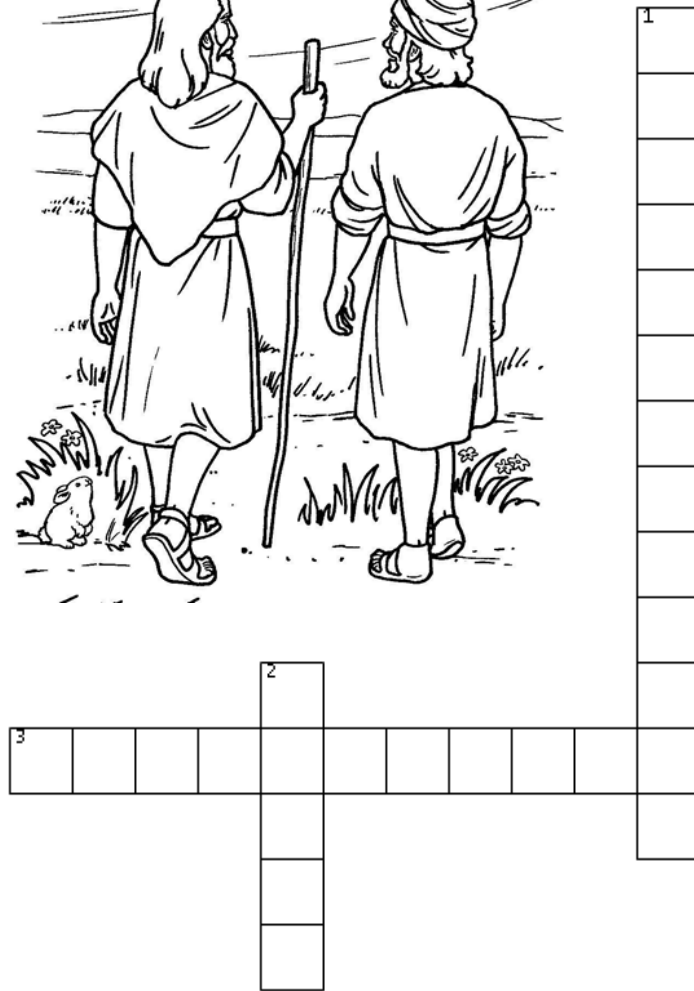
They had wonderful days, feasting and enjoying their time together. They also went together to offer sheep on the _____(trlaa) to thank the Lord for all His care over them.
