



- His blood is transferrable: "For He hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him." (2 Cor. 5:21)

- His blood does not stain but cleanses: "And the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin." (1 John 1:7)

- His blood renews the soul: "But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption." (1 Cor. 1:31)

- Finally, His blood was approved by the heavenly Judge: "And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, "Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said this, he gave up the ghost." (Luke 23:46 "And the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom."
