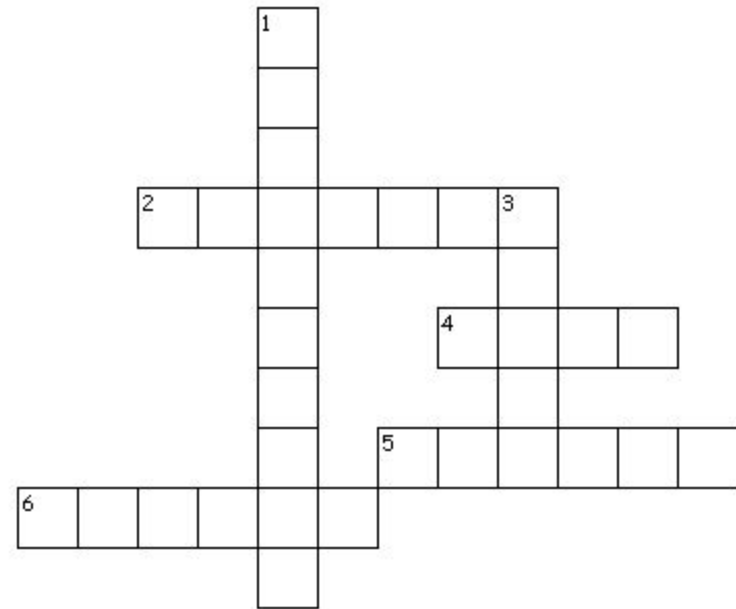
The Israelites were finally f_____. How good the Lord was for His people!
